

2025 Scholarship Application Daughters of Penelope of Golden Gate District 21



The scholarships awarded by the Daughters of Penelope of Golden Gate District 21 are awarded on an academic merit system by a group of unbiased outside evaluators hired by the Daughters of Penelope on an annual basis. The Evaluators may not have any association with any of the candidates or their families or be members of any branch of the AHEPA Family of District 21.

Applicants must read and follow **ALL** of the directions of the Application. Any omission of the required materials or a late postmark date will render the Application incomplete and ineligible for any award consideration. Recipients will receive their cash award once proof of enrollment and payment fee is received by the District Scholarship Chair.

ALL APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED FOR CONSIDERATION MUST BE CLEARLY PRINTED OR TYPED AND POST MARKED BY CERTIFIED MAIL, FEDERAL EXPRESS OR UPS <u>NO LATER THAN APRIL 1, 2025</u>

AWARDS ARE NOT RENEWABLE AND WILL BE ISSUED TO RECIPIENTS ONLY ONCE IN ANY SCHOLARSHIP CATEGORY.

A. ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR UNDERGRADUATE AWARDS → APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Be a female or male high school senior or a recent high school graduate OR undergraduate student at a community college or other public or private college or university. (*Applicant cannot be a former recipient of an undergraduate award of the Daughters of Penelope of Golden Gate District 21 Scholarship program.*)
- **2.** GPA Minimum of 3.0
- Be a member of the Daughters of Penelope or the Maids of Athena of Golden Gate District 21 in good standing for a minimum of two (2) years before the application year OR have a mother or grandmother who has been Daughters of Penelope in good standing in Golden Gate District 21 for a minimum of two (2) years before the application year and has attended four (4) meetings during the fiscal year OR has a father or grandfather who is a Golden Gate District 21 AHEPAN in good standing for a minimum of two (2) years before the application year and who has attended four (4) meetings during the fiscal year.
- **4.** Have the **President** and **Secretary** of the **endorsing chapter** complete the appropriate area of the Application to verify membership of the applicant or immediate family.
- 5. Type a one (1) page essay in English about your educational, vocational and life goals, aspirations and the importance of our Hellenic heritage.
- 6. Provide a current <u>official</u> transcript, in a sealed envelope with a Registrar's stamp, from the high school or college you are currently enrolled in **OR** official electronic transcript sent directly from your educational institution to the Scholarship Chair at dop21scholarship@gmail.com
- 7. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation **dated from the current school year** on proper letterhead from two of the following: clergy, faculty member, aquaintance or employer (not a family member).
- 8. Mandatory Scholarship Application Check List (must be returned with application).
- **9.** The Application and ALL required documents listed above must be included in the applicant's packet, sent Certified Mail, Federal Express of UPS by the applicant directly to the District Scholarship Chair and postmarked by the **application deadline of April 1, 2025**.

B. ELIGIBILITY & APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR GRADUATE AWARDS → <u>APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS</u>

- 1. Be a female (*) and never awarded a graduate scholarship by the Daughters of Penelope
- 2. Be accepted into or be currently enrolled in a M.A., M.S., and M.B.A., PhD., EdD, D.D.S., M.D or other college or university graduate program.
- 3. Be enrolled for a minimum of **nine (9)** units per **academic quarter/semester**.
- 4. GPA Minimum of 3.0
- 5. Be a member of the Daughters of Penelope of Golden Gate District 21 in good standing for a minimum of two (2) years before the application year and have attended four (4) meetings during the year or the daughter or granddaughter of a Daughters of Penelope/AHEPAN of Golden Gate District 21 who is in good standing for a minimum of two (2) years before the application year and has attended four (4) meetings during the fiscal year.
- 6. Have the **President** and **Secretary** of the endorsing chapter complete the appropriate area of the application to verify membership of the applicant or immediate family. Include a current <u>official</u> college or university transcript in a sealed envelope with a Registrar's stamp **OR** have your official electronic transcript sent directly from your educational institution to the Scholarship Chair
- 7. Type a **one (1)** page essay in English about your educational, vocational and life goals, aspirations and the importance of our Hellenic heritage.
- 8. Evidence of acceptance into the graduate program of choice **OR** (if you have completed on or more terms) provide a current official transcript, in a sealed envelope with a Registrar's stamp, from college or university you are currently enrolled in **OR** official electronic transcript sent directly from your educational institution to the Scholarship Chair.
- 9. Two (2) letters of recommendation from the current school year must be dated on proper letterhead from two of the following: Clergy, faculty member, community source, personal acquaintance or employer (not a family member).
- 10. Mandatory Scholarship Application checklist (must be returned with application).
- 11. The Application and ALL required documents listed above must be included in the applicant's packet, sent Certified Mail, Federal Express of UPS by the applicant directly to the District Scholarship Chair and postmarked by the **application deadline of April 1, 2025.**

(*) The Angela Mouroufas Memorial Graduate Scholarship is now available to both female/male students

C. ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR THE RE-ENTRY AWARD → APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Be a female and never awarded a re-entry Scholarship by the Daughters of Penelope
- 2. Be accepted or currently enrolled in a college, university, or vocational school
- **3.** GPA Minimum of 3.0
- 4. Be a member of the Daughters of Penelope of Golden Gate District 21 in good standing for a minimum of two (2) years before the application year and have attended four (4) meetings during the year or the daughter or granddaughter of a Daughters of Penelope/AHEPAN of Golden Gate District 21 who is in good standing for a minimum of two (2) years before the application year and has attended four (4) meetings during the fiscal year.
- 5. Have the **President** and **Secretary** of the endorsing chapter complete the appropriate area on the Application to verify membership.
- 6. A current and/or latest <u>official</u> high school, college, university or vocational training program transcript in a sealed envelope with a Registrar's stamp OR an <u>official</u> electronic transcript sent directly from the educational institution to the Scholarship Chair.
- 7. Type a **one** (1) page essay in English about your educational, vocational, life goals, aspirations and the importance of our Hellenic heritage.
- 8. Two (2) letters of recommendation from the current school year must be dated on proper letterhead from two of the following: clergy, faculty member, community source, personal acquaintance or employer (not a family member).
- 9. Mandatory Scholarship Application checklist (must be returned with application).
- 10. The Application and ALL required documents listed above must be included in the applicant's packet, sent Certified Mail, Federal Express of UPS by the applicant directly to the District Scholarship Chair and postmarked by the **application deadline of April 1, 2025**.

NOTIFICATION AND AWARD PROCEDURE FOR UNDERGRADUATE / GRADUATE / RE-ENTRY SCHOLARSHIPS

The District Scholarship Chair will notify all applicants in writing of their award status at the completion of the evaluation process.

We will recognize Scholarship recipients at our Convention Scholarship Luncheon which will be tentatively held on June 21, 2025. Date will be confirmed soon. All recipients and their families are encouraged to attend this wonderful event.

To receive the **award check**, the District Scholarship Chair must receive from the recipient proof of registration and receipt of tuition payment for the fall term at the college, university or vocational program. After this, the check will be paid directly to the recipient.
